



City of Fernley

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2007 Senate Bill 279 made provisions for a handyman to repair or maintain property the value of which is less than \$1,000, including labor and materials. However, that work must **NOT** require:

- A building permit
- Electrical, plumbing, heating or air conditioning
- Is not performed as part of a larger project

Examples of services which **do not** require a state contractor's license:

1. Mowing, edging, rototilling, and thatching of lawns/garden areas
2. Clean-up and hauling of debris **See note below*
3. Replacement of sprinkler heads which are threaded and screw onto risers
4. Tree and shrub trimming
5. Cleaning
6. Appliance repair
7. Light bulb replacement
8. Evaporative cooler maintenance
9. Filter replacement
10. Faucet washer and seat replacement

Any person who **sells** nursery stock must obtain a license from the Department of Agriculture. This includes retail and wholesale nurseries, hardware and home improvement centers, landscapers, landscape architects, brokers, and peddlers.
