COVID-19 CARES PROGRAM

The COVID-19 CARES Program is funded by the Federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act through Lyon County and partnership with the City of Fernley. Individuals experiencing economic hardship due to the COVID-19 pandemic may be eligible, verification of impact may be required for direct assistance. The qualifications for the COVID-19 CARES funds are that the individual or household must have had a financial impact due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The financial impact can be in a variety of ways such as a temporary business closure, permanent loss of job, lost wages due to having to quarantine without pay, reduction in hours due to business slow down, loss of caregiver support including reduced hours due to having to stay home for school closures. 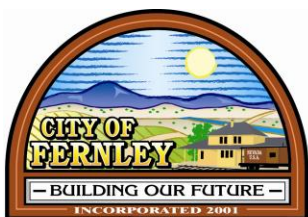

COVID-19 SMALL BUSINESS ECONOMIC ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

As of Monday, October 26th, 2020 the City will again accept applications for the COVID-19 Small Business Economic Assistance Program. The purpose of the program is to assist the City's business community in recovering from the fiscal impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic by providing economic support during the COVID-19 public health emergency. This grant is open to the first fifty (50) eligible applicants. Businesses that have received prior federal, state or local COVID-19 funding are eligible to apply. The City has awarded \$125,000 to local small businesses for the COVID-19 Small Business Economic Assistance Program. CITY COUNCIL MEETINGS ONLINE VIA ZOOM

Pursuant to Section 3 of the Declaration of the Emergency Directive 006, the requirement contained in NRS 241.023(1)(b) that there be a physical location designated for meetings of public bodies where members of the public are permitted to attend and participate has been suspended until further notice. 'Attend' the City Council meetings virtually by clicking on the Zoom link on the meeting agenda. Remember, agendas are posted on the City's website three business days prior to the meeting. VECTOR CONTROL UPDATE

The City of Fernley's Vector Control Department has been working full force to keep the Mosquito populations down this season. We have also trapped and turned in mosquitoes to the Nevada Department of Agriculture. They were tested for West Nile Virus, Equine Encephalitis and St. Louis Encephalitis. HELLO FROM THE FERNLEY PARKS DEPARTMENT

Hello from the Fernley Parks Department! Since we haven't seen much of one another due to COVID-19, we thought we would take a moment and give you a quick update as to what projects we have been working on in the parks. At the Out of Town Parks we installed another pitching bull pen at the Little League Majors field. In the process, we needed to reroute the irrigation waterline to the Little League fields. With youth sports on temporary hold we were able to reseed our sports fields a little earlier this year. The Horseshoe pits at River Ranch parks were rebuilt with new backstops and railroad tie borders. Our planters at Rainbow and Jasmine Streets were cleaned, mulched and new dripline installed. The rest of the time we are doing our day to day building, janitorial, weeds, landscape and turf maintenance. Hope all of you are doing well and we will see you later.

2020 FALL RESIDENTIAL RUBBISH VOUCHER

We all have a stake in the City's appearance. In an effort to remove blight from City of Fernley properties, City Code Enforcement team provided over 235 free Trash Vouchers between October 1-16th, 2020 to residents of Fernley. If you received a voucher, they are good for one free trip to the Fernley Waste Management Transfer Station and can be used until November 30, 2020. Thank you for taking part in this program. We hope to next year's fall clean-up is just as successful.
