Regular Council Meetings are the First and Third Wednesday of each month 5:00 pm at Council Chambers.

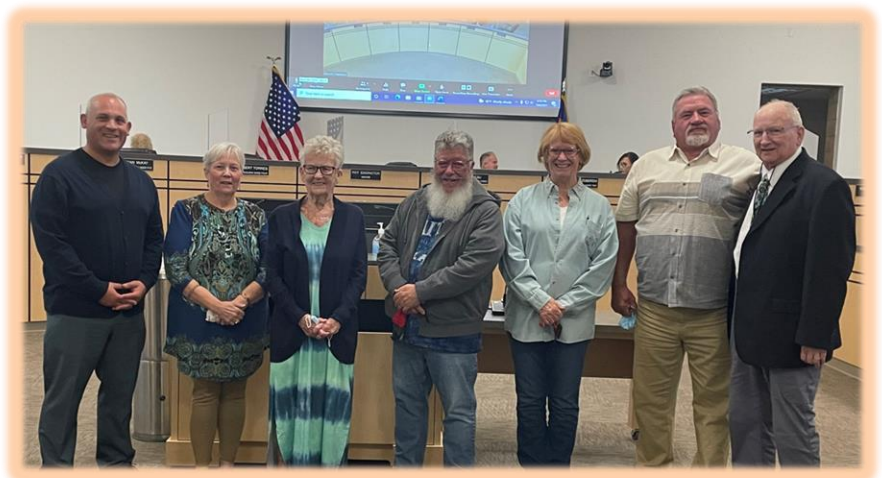
Fernley Planning Commission meets the Second Wednesday of each month 5:00 pm at Council Chambers.

FERNLEY VECTOR CONTROL UPDATE

The City of Fernley Vector Control is happy to inform the community that out of all of the mosquitoes that were trapped, identified, and sent into the Nevada Department of Agriculture all came back with negative results. Vector Control tests the mosquitoes for West Nile Virus, Western Equine Encephalitis and St. Louis Encephalitis.

WINTER DRIVING TIPS

OSHA recommends extra care be taken while driving during the winter months. According to OSHA's [safe winter driving publication](#), motorists should remember the three P's of safe winter driving:



1. *Prepare* for the trip
2. *Protect* yourself
3. *Prevent* crashes on the road

OSHA recommends preparedness include having appropriate safety items on hand throughout the winter months, including: "flashlight, jumper cables, abrasive material (sand, kitty litter, even floor mats), shovel, snow brush and ice scraper, warning devices (like flares) and blankets. For long trips, add food and water, medication and cell phone." Notably, drivers should take extra precautions to identify hazards in the road, including pedestrians, as stopping distances are decreased.
