COTTONWOOD LANE RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT: NEW YEAR UPDATE

The project along the Cottonwood corridor will benefit Cottonwood Elementary School by improving safety, roadway, and pedestrian and bicycle with the addition of riprap stabilization and a handrail along the existing culvert; a dedicated right and left turn lanes; and sidewalk and bike paths that will connect to the existing multi-use path on Farm District. We expect construction to begin 2022.

2022 ELECTION INFORMATION

Filing for Candidacy begins Wednesday March 2nd at the City Clerk's Office in City Hall.

Candidate Eligibility: NRS 266.215 Qualifications of city council members. Council members must be:

- Qualified electors within their respective cities and bona fide residents thereof for a period of at least 1-year next proceeding their election.
- Except as otherwise provided in NRS 266.220, qualified electors within their respective wards.

City of Fernley open seats are Mayor, Ward 1, and Ward 3. The Filing fee is \$25.00
